- V. CORRESPONDENCE AND ANNOUNCEMENTS:
  - a. **Marty Eslamblochi**, DPW Manager, was going to give a presentation on their work in researching potential Grants to aid our effort but due to a potential shift of responsibility from DPW to DPLU, he will not give a report.
  - b. Nancy Slaff, John Long and Marguerite Hampton were seated on this subcommittee at the last Planning Group meeting. That makes 20 seated members now. A quorum/majority is 11 members.
  - c. Jim Bennett will be meeting with East County Planning Group members, County Staff and members of Dianne Jacob's Staff on Mar. 13 at Ruffin Rd. to give an update on his work toward accomplishing a Groundwater Study for San Diego County in support of GP 2020. We will get a report later.
    - A. Status from Jim Bennett on the Water Study he is doing:
      - b. The model has been updated and the calibration with Lee Valley data is comparing well with the Model results.
      - c. Campo, Pine Valley, Boulevard areas will be the first to be run on the model.
      - d. He hopes to have a draft run by the end of April.
      - e. Public review of the results will be at the end of the year as part of the EIR for GP2020. Larry will ask Jim Bennet to present some more information
      - f. He also informed me that the County has applied for a \$120,000 Grant to create a "Template for a Groundwater

Management Plan for the County”. Again, the competition is very tough.

- d. There is going to be an Annual Meeting of the Borrego Springs Water District in Borrego Springs on Feb. 22 at 6PM. They are the only group in the East County with a Groundwater Management Plan. I will attend if possible to learn and make contacts. It is public so everyone is invited.
